

SUDIP BOSE (WCAS95, FSM99)

The American College of Emergency Physicians and HealthLeaders magazine named Sudip Bose ("Saving Soldiers," winter 2005) one of America's health care leaders. During a 15-month deployment to Iraq with the U.S. Army in the mid-2000s, Bose treated thousands of soldiers and Iraqis, including Saddam Hussein, and earned a Bronze Star for his service.
