

- Helped start and is a current member of the Advisory Board of DrB.ai, a global health
  platform led by doctors that use digital tools to give patients access to safe, affordable
  medical care.
- Trusted Advisor to the U.S. Congress on healthcare policy and a sought-after keynote speaker for Fortune 500 companies and leading financial institutions.

Through all of these roles, Dr Bose connects the dots between healthcare, military leadership, and business strategy. His story is not just about medicine—it is about decision-making under pressure, resilience in uncertainty, and innovation in the service of others.

While many physicians confine themselves to clinical work, Dr Bose has expanded his impact through entrepreneurship and media innovation.
