A former US Army combat physician, Dr. Bose provided care to soldiers in Iraq's most dangerous war zones and treated Saddam Hussein following his 2003 capture. He currently practices emergency medicine at Medical Center Hospital in West Texas, the highest-level trauma center across 38,000 square miles, and continues to drive systemic improvements in healthcare delivery.
